





INDUSTRIES AT RISK




MINING, QUARRYING, AND OIL AND GAS EXTRACTION (NAICS 21)

- An estimated 4,758 EMPLOYEES (38% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$418,000



RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)

- An estimated 13,999 EMPLOYEES (31% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$2.6 million



WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 3,613 EMPLOYEES (31% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$1.2 million
