
NEW YORK

According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, 2,016,847 NEW YORK WORKERS (22% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, complying with this mandate will cost New York businesses at least \$146 million.



INDUSTRIES AT RISK



WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 66,194 EMPLOYEES (17% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$11 million



RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)

- An estimated 219,227 EMPLOYEES (22% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$22.1 million



PROFESSIONAL, SCIENTIFIC, AND TECHNICAL SERVICES (NAICS 54)

- An estimated 143,224 EMPLOYEES (20% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$21.0 million
