
### THE ECONOMIC COST OF VACCINE MANDATES

# OHIO

According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, 1,880,236 OHIO WORKERS

(33% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, complying with this mandate will cost Ohio businesses at least \$104 million.




## INDUSTRIES AT RISK



#### **MANUFACTURING (NAICS 31-33)**

- An estimated 293,812 EMPLOYEES (37% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$15.2 million



#### **WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)**

- An estimated 83,599 EMPLOYEES (31% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$10.9 million



#### **RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)**

- An estimated 230,590 EMPLOYEES (36% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$17.8 million

## U.S. National Average



- An estimated 44,966,434 EMPLOYEES (28% of the U.S. Labor Force) will be at risk of losing their jobs from the Biden's Vaccine Mandate
- According to the Biden Administration's own estimates,
   U.S. businesses will spend at least \$1.29 billion in
