
VIRGINIA

According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, 1,044,560 VIRGINIA WORKERS (25% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, complying with this mandate will cost Virginia businesses at least \$84 million.



INDUSTRIES AT RISK



WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 32,668 EMPLOYEES (24% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$6.2 million



RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)


- An estimated 150,318 EMPLOYEES (28% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$16.1 million



PROFESSIONAL, SCIENTIFIC, AND TECHNICAL SERVICES (NAICS 54)

- An estimated 153,812 EMPLOYEES (25% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$15.9 million
