
# WASHINGTON



According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, 898,366 WASHINGTON WORKERS (23% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, complying with this mandate will cost Washington businesses at least \$73 million.



## INDUSTRIES AT RISK



#### WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 42,948 EMPLOYEES (23% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$7.9 million



#### **RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)**

- An estimated 117,647 EMPLOYEES (25% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$13.9 million



#### **MANUFACTURING (NAICS 31-33)**

- An estimated 99,308 EMPLOYEES (27% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$5.9 million

- An estimated 44,966,434 EMPLOYEES (28% of the U.S. Labor Force) will be at risk of losing their jobs from the Biden's Vaccine Mandate
