
I am writing to follow up on my previous letters dated October 2, 2013, December 10, 2013, and December 10, 2013, asking for details regarding your efforts to promote the Lifeline mobile phone program. Your involvement in promoting Lifeline included another visit to Louisiana in November 2014. The Lifeline program continues to be plagued by claims of fraud and abuse that cost taxpayers, including small business owners, billions of dollars. As you are well aware, these allegations have compelled me look into this matter.

In my previous letters, I asked you a number of questions that remain unanswered. Accordingly, I again ask that you please answer the following:

1. Press reports of your visits to Louisiana include quotes vaguely asserting that a public affairs company that represents veterans' advocacy groups sponsored your trip. What is the name of this company and what is the identity of its financial backers? Was this entity the sponsor of your 2014 visits to the state?
2. Do any entities who receive funds from the Lifeline program financially support either the above-mentioned public affairs company, you, your political action committee, or any entity in which you have an interest? If so, what are the entities' names and how much financial support do they provide to you, your political action committee, or any entity in which you have an interest?
