RHODE ISLAND



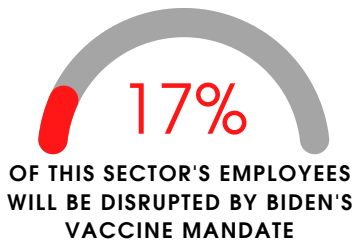
According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, **96,630 RHODE ISLAND WORKERS** (18% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, **complying with this mandate will cost Rhode Island businesses at least \$20 million.**

INDUSTRIES AT RISK



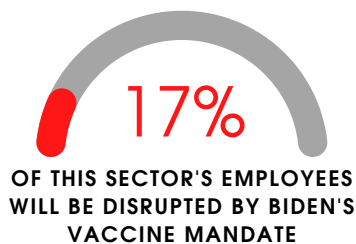
WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated **4,302 EMPLOYEES** (17% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$1.8 million



RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)

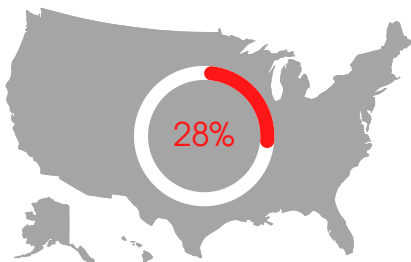
- An estimated **11,417 EMPLOYEES** (20% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$5.5 million



MANUFACTURING (NAICS 31-33)

- An estimated **8,390 EMPLOYEES** (17% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$1.1 million

U.S. National Average



- An estimated **44,966,434 EMPLOYEES** (28% of the U.S. Labor Force) will be at risk of losing their jobs from the Biden's Vaccine Mandate
- According to the **Biden Administration's own estimates**, U.S. businesses will spend **at least \$1.29 billion in complying with the vaccine mandate**
