

ALABAMA

According to data gathered from the U.S. Census Bureau and the Centers for Disease Control, 821,222 ALABAMA WORKERS (37% of the total labor force) are at risk of losing their jobs. Using the Biden Administration's own estimates, complying with this mandate will cost Alabama businesses at least \$53 million.




INDUSTRIES AT RISK




MANUFACTURING (NAICS 31-33)

- An estimated 152,187 EMPLOYEES (46% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$6.2 million



WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 32,549 EMPLOYEES (35% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$5.6 million



RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)

- An estimated 110,794 EMPLOYEES (38% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$10.6 million
