

RETAIL TRADE (NAICS 44-45)

- An estimated 25,243 EMPLOYEES (30% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$5.6 million



WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS 42)

- An estimated 4,845 EMPLOYEES (22% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$1.7 million



ACCOMODATION AND FOOD SERVICES (NAICS 72)

- An estimated 34,689 EMPLOYEES (26% of total employees in this sector) are unvaccinated and work at a firm with 100 or more employees
- Complying with the vaccine mandate will cost these businesses at least \$1.4 million
