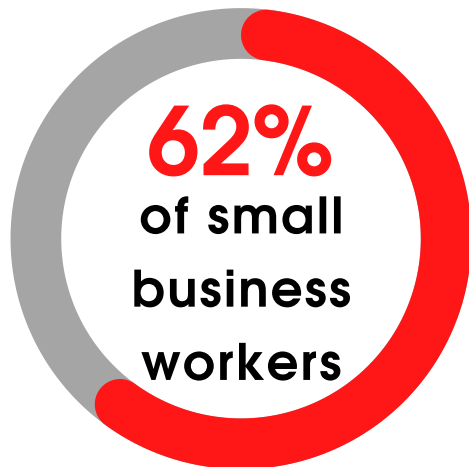
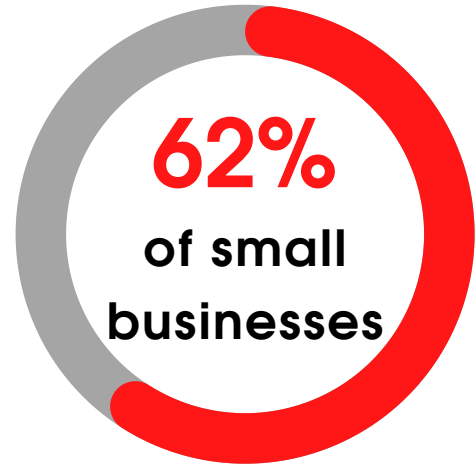


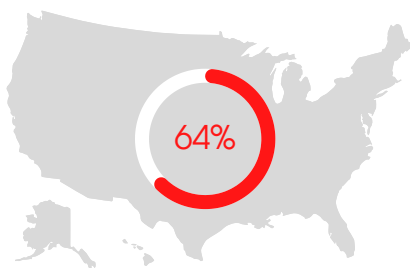
ALABAMA

In the midst of historical levels of inflation (**9.1% over the last year**), Democrats are considering increasing taxes to pass-through business owners. While Democrats claim that their tax hikes are aimed at the wealthy shareholders, these business owners employ **62% of the state's small business workforce**, which would put an estimated **1,025,746 workers in danger**.
