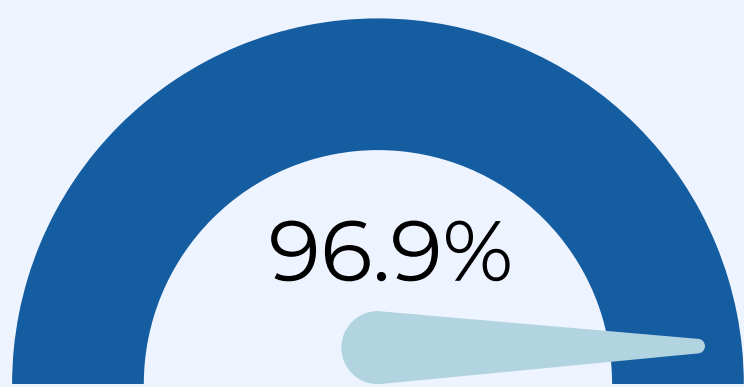


# Economic Costs of WOTUS on Small Businesses

According to SBA Office of Advocacy data, President Biden's new WOTUS Rule will impact **58,145 OKLAHOMA** small businesses

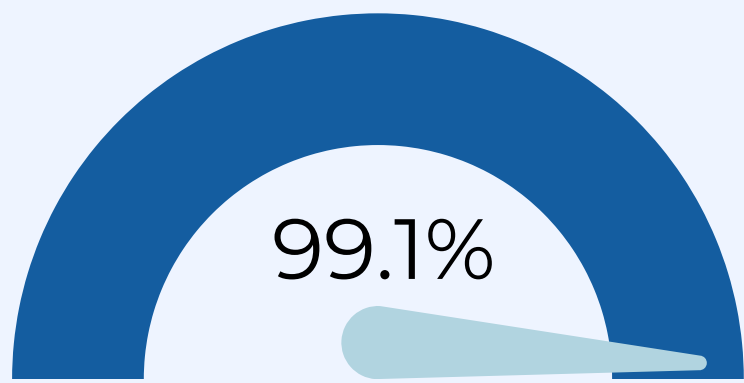
### INDUSTRIES AT RISK

#### Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting

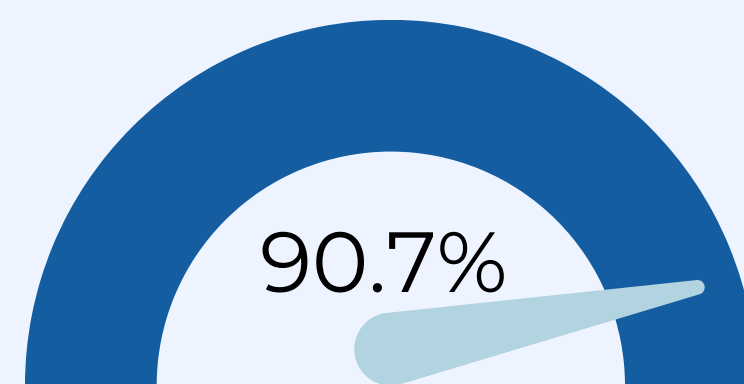
An estimated 4,408 SMALL BUSINESSES are impacted  
An estimated 760 EMPLOYEES are impacted

#### Construction

An estimated 46,702 SMALL BUSINESSES are impacted  
An estimated 65,258 EMPLOYEES are impacted

#### Manufacturing

An estimated 7,035 SMALL BUSINESSES are impacted  
An estimated 54,548 EMPLOYEES are impacted

The EPA and the Army Corps of Engineers unveiled their final **Revised Definition of WOTUS**, which would significantly **expand regulations around permits** for land and building projects. It would create significant uncertainty around what criteria will be used to determine whether a permit is ultimately awarded. The Rule would even require private individuals to prove water on their land is **not** under the federal government's jurisdiction. The rule is **effective starting March 20, 2023**.
